



PUBLIC COLLOQUIUM 2020 of the Artistic Research PhD Programme

In accordance with the measures concerning covid.19 the Public Colloquium 2020 will be held online. It will consist of: 1) pre-recorded audio-visual presentations, 2) a collection of reviews on the presentations and 3) an online symposium stream (Zoom Webinar). The event will be open for participants (PhD candidates and their supervisors) as well as for guests.

1) PRESENTATIONS: Each PhD candidate will provide a 15-20-minute audio-visual presentation on the current status of his or her research project. Beside the presentation, there will be short introduction of the project in form of a separate audio-visual file (max 5min) or in written form.

The files will be made accessible for all participants as well as for registered guests one week in advance of the actual event.

2a) INTERNAL FEEDBACK: To intensify the reflexive discussion during the symposium stream, all candidates are asked to provide reviews on the presentations of two colleagues. The collected contributions are released for viewing by all participants and guests.

2b) EXTERNAL FEEDBACK: Zentrum Fokus Forschung will invite two external guests from the field of artistic research, to the colloquium. They are asked contribute to the discussion by giving feedback to the presentations.

D) SYMPOSIUM STREAM: During the online meeting (Zoom Webinar) there will be room for joint reflective discussion of the presentation and the progress of the project. The guests are invited to use the chat resp. the Q&A function to submit questions, suggestions and comments in moderated form.

In order to take part in the symposium stream and get access to the content, guests are asked to register by writing to zff@uni-ak.ac.at till May 31.
